## Find a US Senate bill, where xxxx = bill number:

To use – copy the URL below into a browser window, replace xxxx with the US Senate bill number, hit return. You will be directed to the bill information on the congress website if you provided a currently active bill number.

## <u>Find a US House bill, where xxxx = bill number</u>:

## How to find a bill number if you only have the "short title" - for US legislation:

To use – open the link. Cut and paste (or type) the "short title" name into the "search title & full text" field. If you know the bill sponsor, select them by using the pull-down menu in the "sponsor" field. Adjust the "congress" year as required. Hit the "search" button. Scroll through the legislation list to find an appropriate match (Often the last entry is the one I want, but probably because I almost always search for legislation shortly after it is introduced).
